The objective of the course is to prepare candidates for the difficult task of finding employment. The course is based on a series of film clips which recount the realistic experience of a recent graduate looking for his first professional position. The topics range from networking and company research to writing resumes, cover letters and letters of reference. The also explore the emotional and psychological aspects of a job hunt. The film clips are accompanied by additional textual support and resources.

Upon completion of the course material, the candidates are required to write a resume and cover letter. These documents are then submitted for revision to the instructor, who will then make the appropriate corrections and observations on how to improve them. At this point, mock interviews via Skype are scheduled for the candidates with an American consultant with years of experience in interviewing candidates for positions in the professional world. In addition, she is also assistant dean at a leading American university. This combination of experience makes her the perfect choice for graduate students, who may be looking for employment in either professional or academic fields.
