### Some practical information



- PhD: Student or Researcher? BOTH!
- As a researcher, you have a scholarship, you pay social security contributions, you can ask for maternity/paternity leaves
- As a student, you are entitled in receiving accommodation in the student residences, meals in the University canteens, and take advantage of some facilities

# In case of admission ...



- Doctoral degree programs will begin on or before the date of 30 November 2021 and will conclude with the submission of an original doctoral dissertation, preferably in English language. The course length is 3 years
- In addition to the activities directly related to the preparation of the dissertation, all PhD students are required to participate in teaching activities carried out in English, organized by the SAS, and in the courses held as part of the curricular pathway.
- Student mobility experiences outside the University, in Italy and abroad, shall also be provided

### How the PhD course is structured

The Doctoral program consists of 180 ECTS credits for research work and training activities, in order to contribute to a better recognition of your title at a European and global level

First and Second Year:

- 40 ECTS in research activity (with a yearly evaluation)
- 10 ECTS in mandatory SAS Activities to acquire transferable skills (two weeks /year)
- 10 ECTS in curricular related activities: 7 ECTS for participation in thematic option courses ; 3 ECTS for participation in seminars and events

### Third year:

- 50 ECTS in research activity (writing and defend the Doctoral dissertation)
- 10 ECTS in mandatory SAS Activities to acquire transferable skills (two weeks / year)

### Some useful information about PhD



Scholarship: the netto monthly amount of the scholarship is 1132,72€. Fees: there are no tuition fees. Every year, PhDs are requested to pay € 156 (regional fee) upon enrollment

### For International Phds



 Candidates who have obtained the academic qualification abroad, for enrolment purposes, must submit the Declaration of Equivalence, issued by the Italian Embassy of the country in which the qualification was issued, or the Statement of Comparability and Verification of the Qualification, issued by CIMEA (Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence).



# Visa, Permit to stay in Italy

Non-EU PhD candidates must comply with the rules relating to entry visas and make a request for the issue and annual renewal of the residence permit. The cost of the permit, of about € 120.00 (one hundred and twenty euros/00 cents) must be paid by the applicant.



### Health insurance

The University offers a health insurance coverage for ER and hospitalization to all first year students

However, registration in the Italian National Healthcare Service is mandatory from the second year of the PhD course

### Mobility

- PhD candidates have to spend at least three / six months as **visiting scholar** in a foreign University or research institution, depending on their research interests.
- PhD candidates with a scholarship, going abroad, have the right to grant a 50% increase of the monthly scholarship.
- Every PhD candidate has a small amount of money (i.e. 3,068.66 €) to support short term mobility, research and training activities

### Accommodation



CAMERINO IS A UNIVERSITY CAMPUS SURROUNDED BY NATURE. IT OFFERS STUDENTS THE TRANQUILLITY THEY NEED FOR THEIR STUDIES. STUDENT RESIDENCES FOR OVER 900 PLACES, TWO CANTEENS AND A STUDENT CAFETARIAS ARE MANAGED BY ERDIS (REGIONAL AGENCY FOR THE RIGHT TO HIGHER EDUCATION) ALL ROOMS ARE FURNISHED AND PROVIDED WITH WIFI INTERNET CONNECTION, A TELEPHONE TO RECEIVE DIRECT PRIVATE CALLS (WITHOUT A SWITCHBOARD OPERATOR), BED LINEN AND LAUNDRY FACILITIES. HEATING,ELECTRICITY AND WATER ARE INCLUDED IN THE SERVICE. (THE COST OF THE ROOM IS MORE OR LESS € 200 /MONTH) THE **AVERAGE COST** FOR A COMPLETE **MEAL** (1<sup>ST</sup> COURSE, 2<sup>ND</sup> COURSE, SIDE DISH AND DESSERT) AT THE UNIVERSITY CANTEENS IS ABOUT **5€**.
